

"Snow White Discovers the Cottage" Quilt

Quilt approximate size 48" x 56"

All border strip length measurements are approximate. Please measure your quilt top before cutting the length of each border.

Fabric Requirements

Fabric A: Snow White Panel	1 panel of TK-9010-9C-1
Fabric B: Coral Gate Scroll	1/3 yard of TK-9012-9C-2
Fabric C: Brown Words	1/4 yard of TK-9604-9C-1
Fabric D: Green Words	1/3 yard of TK-9604-9C-2
Fabric E: Pink Gate Scroll	3/8 yard of TK-9012-9C-1
Fabric F: Pink Stars	1/2 yard of TK-9598-9C-5
Fabric G: Lt. Green Leaves	3/4 yard of TK-9606-9C-3
Fabric H: Tan Gate Scroll	7/8 yard of TK-9012-9C-9
Fabric I: Enchanted Flowers	1-1/2 yards of TK-9014-9C-1
Fabric J: Snow White Patch	1/3 yard of TK-9600-9C-1
Fabric K: Green Leaves	7/8 yard of TK-9606-9C-1
Fabric L: Dk. Green Leaves	1/3 yard of TK-9606-9C-2
Backing	3-1/4 yards of your choice

- Fussy cut one large panel 12-1/2" x 18-1/2"
- Fussy cut four small panels 8-1/2" square
- Cut forty-eight 1-7/8" squares.
- Cut sixteen 2-7/8" squares.
- Cut four 1" x 7-1/2" strips from the length of Fabric (LOF) and four 1" x 8-1/2" strips from the width of fabric (WOF).
- Cut thirty-two 2-7/8" squares and eight 2-1/2" squares.
- Cut forty-eight 1-7/8" squares and sixty-four 1-1/2" squares.
- Cut sixteen 2-7/8" squares and sixteen 2-1/2" squares.
- Cut five 1-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips for the inner border.
- Cut eight 2-1/2" x 8-1/2", four 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" and four 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips for the sashing.
- Cut two 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips for the side borders from the LOF. Cut three 3-1/2" x 34" strips from the WOF. Piece the strips together to make two 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips.
- Fussy cut two 6-1/2" square patches.
- Cut sixteen 2-7/8" squares.
- Cut two 3" x 16-1/2" strips and two 2" x 19-1/2" strips.
- Cut five 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
- Cut sixteen 2-7/8" squares.
- Cut four 1" x 7-1/2", four 1" x 6-1/2", two 1" x 18-1/2" and two 1" x 13-1/2" strips.
- Cut two 56" x WOF strips. Piece into one 56" x 64" backing.

Assembly Instructions:

- 1) Place one 2-7/8" Fabric C square on top of one 2-7/8" Fabric G square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper right corner to lower left corner (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two 2-1/2" half-square triangles (Fig. 3). Repeat to make sixteen more C/G half-square triangles with the seam going from the upper right to lower left corner.
- 2) Repeat Step 1 with the remaining sixteen 2-7/8" Fabric C and G squares, this time sewing across the directional Fabric C square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner.
- 3) Repeat Step 1 and 2 to make thirty-two 2-1/2" Fabric K/E half-square triangles and thirty-two 2-1/2" Fabric L/E half-square triangles with the directional fabric from each pair on top from the 2-7/8" squares.
- 4) Place one 1-1/2" Fabric F square on the E corner of one K/E half-square triangle. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim the excess fabric behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat with all the 2-1/2" K/E and 2-1/2" L/E half-square triangles.
- 5) Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make ninety-six 1-1/2" B/F half-square triangles with the directional fabric from each pair on top using the 1-7/8" squares.
- 6) Follow the block layout to sew together eight pieced blocks using the half-square triangles and the 2-1/2" Fabric E squares.
- 7) To make the center panel, sew one 1" x 18-1/2" Fabric L strip to each side of the 12-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew one 1" x 13-1/2" Fabric L strip to the top and bottom of the center panel. Sew one 2" x 19-1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of the center panel. Sew one 3" x 16-1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and bottom of the center panel. Sew one 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the center panel.
- 8) To make a patch block, sew one 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric L strip to each side of one 6-1/2" Fabric J square. Sew one 1" x 7-1/2" Fabric L strip to the top and bottom of the 6-1/2" Fabric J square. Sew one 1" x 7-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the 6-1/2" square. Sew one 1" x 8-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the 6-1/2" square to make one Patch blocks. Repeat to make a second patch block.
- 9) Sew one pieced block from Step 6 to the top and bottom of each patch block to make two vertical rows. Sew the side borders to the center panel to make the center section. Sew one 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the pieced rows to complete the center section.
- 10) Place one 2-1/2" Fabric G square to the top left corner of one 8-1/2" Fabric A panel, right sides together. Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 5). Trim away the excess fabric 1/4" from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam. Repeat with three more 2-1/2" Fabric G squares and the remaining three corners to complete the small panel. Repeat with the remaining three 8-1/2" Fabric A panels and 2-1/2" Fabric G squares. Sew one 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the panels to complete the four corner blocks.
- 11) To make the top pieced row, refer to the quilt photo for block placement and sew two pieced blocks together. Sew one corner block to each side of the sewn blocks. Sew one 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the top row. Sew the top pieced row to the center section. Repeat to make the bottom pieced row. Sew the bottom pieced row to the center section to complete the quilt top.
- 12) Sew one 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 13) Sew one 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 14) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

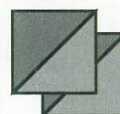


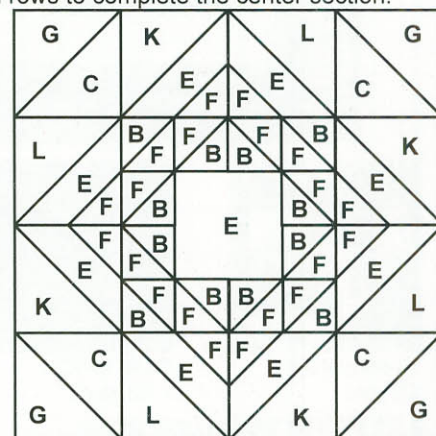
