Materials Needed:

2/3 yard of #1282 panel
1/3 yard each of #1281 (giraffe),
#1279 (elephant), #1280 (lion), #247
(zebra), #1284 (gorilla), #256 (cheetah),
#237 (earth)
1/3 yard of black solid

Binding: 1/2 yard your choice

Backing & Matching Sleeve - 3 yards

Batting: Warm & Natural Baby Size



1. Choose your favorite three panels from fabric (#1282). Cut panels to 8 1/2" x 12 1/2".

2. From the beige solid and the black solid, cut (3) 2 1/2" strips by the width of fabric. Stitch a strip of black to a strip of beige. Cross cut into 2 1/2" segments and re-stitch into a four patch unit. Make a total of 29 four patch units that will measure 4 1/2" unfinished.

3. Cut 4 1/2" squares from the remaining fabrics as follows:

Gorilla	14 squares
Zebra	16 squares
Cheetah	20 squares
Lion	7 squares
Giraffe	6 squares
Elephant	11 squares

Note: You will be "fussy" cutting the Lion, Giraffe and Elephant fabrics. Slide

the ruler around so that you get as many different views as possible.

4. Referring to the photo above, lay out your four patch units, large panels and squares.

5. Assemble in vertical rows inserting the big panel in the appropriate places.

6. Layer, baste and quilt as desired. Bind using 2 1/2" strips of your chosen fabric. Don't forget to attach a label.

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
