 Finished Quilt Size: 74" x 98" - Block Size: 12" square
 "Changing Seasons" Fabrics—Style #3551—by Classic Cottons

Fabric Requirements: (Yardage based on 44" wide fabrics)

- 1 yard black solid (Classic Cottons Solids #400-888 Black)
- See Table for yardage requirements of Changing Seasons fabrics
- 3/4 yard fabric for binding (#9519-6 very dark green print suggested)
- 5-7/8 yards fabric for backing (#9522-6 light green print suggested)
- 80" x 104" quilt batting

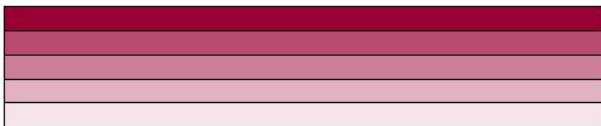

3/8 yard each print	Fuchsia	#9523-1	#9522-1	#9521-1	#9520-1	#9519-1
3/8 yard each print	Orange	#9523-7	#9522-7	#9521-7	#9520-7	#9519-7
3/8 yard each print	Blue	#9523-2	#9522-2	#9521-2	#9520-2	#9519-2
3/8 yard each print	Purple	#9523-3	#9522-3	#9521-3	#9520-3	#9519-3

Cutting Directions: (A 1/4" seam allowance is included in all measurements)

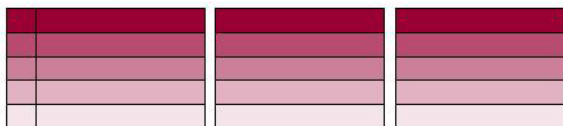
- Black Print: Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 44" strips, from three strips cut thirty-five 2-1/2" squares
- For Blocks: Cut seven 1-1/2" x 44" strips each of all the fuchsia, orange, blue and purple prints.
- For Border: Cut nine 1-1/2" x 44" strips each of the five green prints
- Binding: Cut nine 2-1/2" x 44" strips
- Backing: Cut backing fabric into two equal lengths then stitch together along selvage edge.

Sewing Directions:

1. Make a total of seven panels of fuchsia fabrics each with the five prints from dark to light.

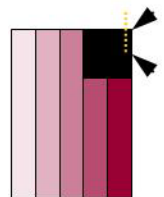


2. From these panels cut a total of thirty-five strips 5-1/2" x 7-1/2".

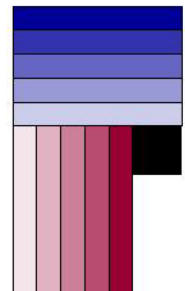


3. Repeat Steps #1 and #2 with the blue prints, purple prints and orange prints.

4. Lay a black square on a fuchsia pieced strip as shown and stitch a seam only where shown between the arrows. Press seam to black fabric.



5. Add a blue pieced strip to the top of this section as shown.

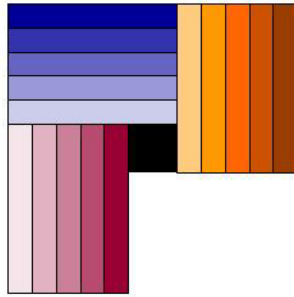


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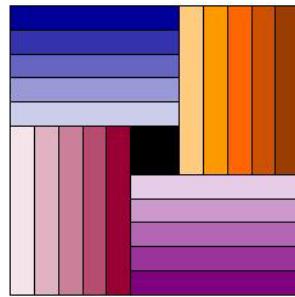
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Sewing Directions Continued:

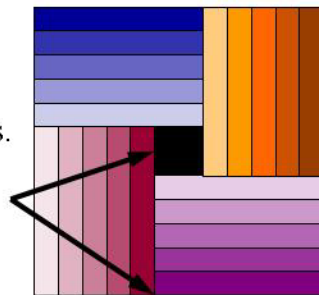
6. Add the orange pieced strip to the side.



7. Sew the purple pieced strip to the bottom of the black square and the orange pieced strip.



8. Finish the seam on the fuchsia strip as shown between arrows.



9. Make a total of thirty-five blocks.
10. Lay out blocks in seven vertical rows of five blocks each. Stitch blocks into rows then sew rows together.
11. Make four borders each with two black 2-1/2" x 44" strips sewn together end-to-end. Cut remaining 2-1/2" x 44" black strip into two equal lengths and stitch each half strip end-to-end with a double-length strip. Stitch the strips with two and a half lengths to the right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess from these and all successive border additions.

12. Add remaining double-length borders to the top and bottom of quilt. Press and trim excess.
13. Add the green borders with 1-1/2" strips in the same manner (Steps #11 & #12), starting with the pale green working out to the very dark green as the last border.
14. Layer backing, batting and quilt top. Baste layers together. Quilt or tie as desired.
15. Prepare binding from nine strips of 2-1/2" x 44" dark green fabric. Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.
16. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.
17. Leaving an 8" tail of binding, sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12" from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Stitch together where these two loose ends meet. Finish sewing tape to quilt.
18. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
19. Sign and date your work.
