Finished Quilt Approximately: 37" x 37" - Quilt Center: 18" x 18"

**Spice Market** fabrics by Exclusively Quilters - Style #3708

## **Fabric Requirements:** Based on 44" wide fabric

1/6 yard cream fine vine (#8639-9)

1/6 yard gold vine (#8637-4)

1/6 yard orange fine vine (#8639-7)

1/6 yard green vine (#8637-6)

1/6 yard red vine (#8637-1)

1-1/8 yards black fine vine (#8639-8)

1/2 yard large floral (#8633-8)

2/3 yard black floral (#8635-8)

2/3 yard paisley (#8634-4)

2/3 yard cream floral (#8635-9)

1-1/4 yards fabric for backing (#8633-8 large floral suggested)

42" x 42" quilt batting

An added 1/8 to 1/2 yard is added to all yardages to account for shrinkage, straightening, cutting errors and prints that may require special cutting to get the best results.

You should protect your investment in time and fabric by making sample blocks before cutting into your fabric because Exclusively Quilters will take no responsibility for replacing fabrics.

Shops who wish to kit this design are responsible for figuring yardage for their kits if they wish to reduce yardages.

## **Cutting Directions:** All measurements based on a 1/4" seam allowance.

From the **cream fine vine** fabric:

Cut one 2" x 44" strips then recut into four 2" squares

From the **gold vine** fabric:

Cut one 2" x 44" strips then recut into eight 2" squares

From the **orange fine vine** fabric:

Cut one 2" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 2" squares

From the **green vine** fabric:

Cut one 2" x 44" strips then recut into sixteen 2" squares

From the **red vine** fabric:

Cut one 2" x 44" strips then recut into twenty 2" squares

From the **black fine vine** fabric:

Cut one 2-3/8" x 44" strips then recut into twelve 2-3/8" squares\*

Cut two 2" x 44" strips for border recut into two 19" and two 22" lengths

Cut four 2-1/2" x 44" strips for binding

Cut eight 1-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **large floral** fabric:

Cut one 13-1/4" x 44" strips then recut into one 13-1/4" square

From the **black floral** fabric:

Cut four 3-1/2" x 44" strips, then from each strip cut one 3-1/2" square (4 total)

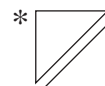
From the **paisley** fabric:

Cut four 3-1/2" x 44" strips for border

From the **cream floral** fabric:

Cut four 3-1/2" x 44" strips for border

Cut squares  
as indicated:

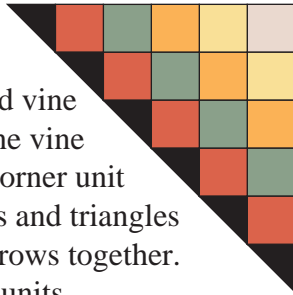


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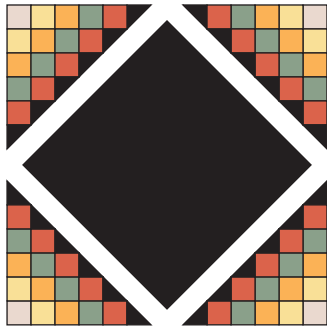
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## Quilt Center:

1. Lay out the 2" cream fine vine, gold vine, orange fine vine, green vine and red vine squares and 2-3/8" black fine vine half-square triangles for a corner unit as shown. Stitch the squares and triangles into rows and then sew the rows together. Make a total of four corner units.



2. Stitch a pieced corner unit to all sides of the 13-1/4" large floral square.

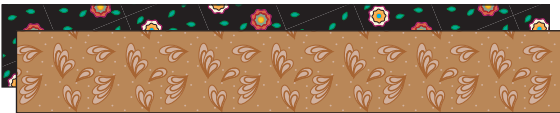


3. Stitch a 2" x 19" fine black strip to right and left sides of quilt center. Press and trim excess. Add 2" x 22" fine black strips to top and bottom of center, press and trim.

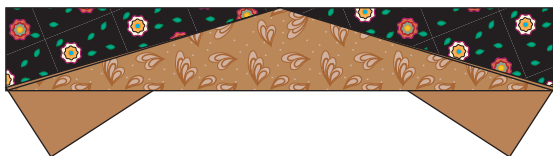
## Pieced Borders:

1. Trim the four 3-1/2" x 44" black floral and four 3-1/2" paisley strips to the same length as the four sides of the quilt center border (about 21-1/2").

2. Lay a trimmed paisley strip right sides up on each of the four trimmed black floral strips, also right sides up.



3. Fold two opposite corners of the paisley strip down between the two strips - forming the long border triangle. The center point should be 1/4" from the edge of the floral strip (so it isn't sewn into the seam). The ends of the paisley strip should cross where the 1/4" seams will intersect the pieces. Press fold and then trim excess to 1/4" seam allowance. Pin in place.



4. Hand or machine stitch the paisley triangles to the black floral backgrounds. If machine stitching, use a matching or clear nylon thread in the needle and a matching or neutral all-purpose thread in the bobbin. Set machine for a hemming or overcast stitch.



5. Sew pieced borders to the right and left sides with the long paisley side to the inside.

6. Sew 3-1/2" black floral squares to the ends of the remaining two borders. Add these to the top and bottom of the quilt with the paisley fabric on the inside.



## Final Borders:

1. Stitch 1-1/2" x 44" black strips to right and left sides of quilt. Press and trim excess. Add 1-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

2. Add a 3-1/2" cream floral border in the same manner.

3. Add a 1-1/2" black black border in the same manner.

## Finishing:

1. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Quilt or tie as desired.

2. Prepare binding from four 2-1/2" x 44" strips of black fine vine . Sew strips together into one long binding strip. Press strip in half lengthwise.

3. Carefully trim backing and batting even with quilt top.

4. Sew binding to top of quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners.

5. Turn binding to back of quilt and blind stitch in place.
